# Overview: Memorials Process (Senate Bylaw 90)

### Part I. Divisional Senate Consideration

 Memorials to the Regents initiated by one Division of the UC Academic Senate are first considered by the other nine UC Divisional Senates to determine whether to advance the proposal to a vote of the entire UC Academic membership.

1. One UC Divisional Senate approves proposed Memorial

2.Proposed Memorial Submitted to Systemwide Senate Chair and other Divisions

3. Each UC Divisional Senate votes on the Memorial based on local procedures.

4. Each UC Divisional Senate Chair reports the results of the Divisional vote to the systemwide Senate.

5. Systemwide Senate Chair notifies all Divisions of the results.

Within 30 days of Step 1

Within 90 days of Step 2

Within 90 days of Step 2

As soon as Step 4 is complete

### **OUTCOME OF PART I.**

If <u>at least 3 Divisions representing at least 35% of the entire UC Academic Senate membership</u> approve, the proposed Memorials proceed to Part II (a vote of the entire UC membership). If the number of approvals does not satisfy this requirement, the proposed Memorial is disapproved, and no further action can be taken.

# Part II. Consideration by Entire UC Academic Senate Membership

 Memorials to the Regents approved in accordance with the previous slide are submitted to a ballot of all voting members of the UC Academic Sepate.

 Systemwide Senate Chair oversees compilation of materials for ballot. 2.Systemwide Senate Parliamentarian submits proposed memorial to a ballot.

3. Each UC Divisional Senate distributes the ballot to all voting Senate members.

4. Each UC Divisional Senate Chair reports the results of the Divisional vote to the systemwide Senate.

5. Systemwide Senate Chair notifies all Divisions of the results.

SW Senate Chair may appoint ad hoc committee to prepare arguments and rebuttals for and against Within 60 days of Conclusion of Divisional Votes

At least 14 days after Step 2.

After Step 5 is complete

### **OUTCOME OF PART II.**

A Memorial that has received a majority of the valid ballots cast is sent by the Systemwide Senate Chair to the UC President for submission to the Regents.
