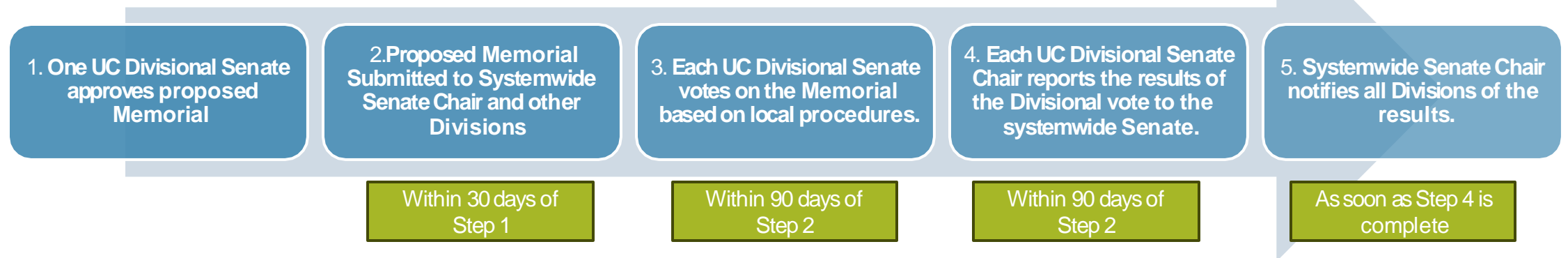

# Overview: Memorials Process (Senate Bylaw 90)

## Part I. Divisional Senate Consideration

- Memorials to the Regents initiated by one Division of the UC Academic Senate are first considered by the other nine UC Divisional Senates to determine whether to advance the proposal to a vote of the entire UC Academic membership.



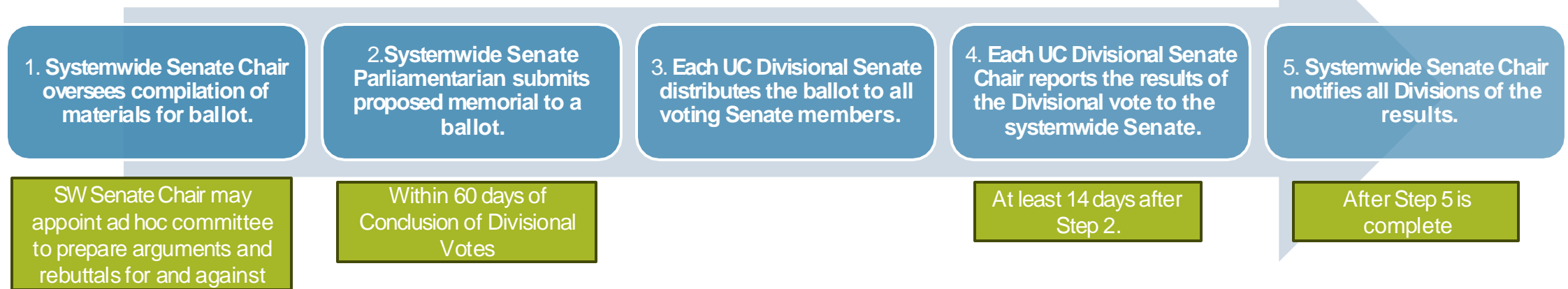
### OUTCOME OF PART I.

If at least 3 Divisions representing at least 35% of the entire UC Academic Senate membership approve, the proposed Memorials proceed to Part II (a vote of the entire UC membership). If the number of approvals does not satisfy this requirement, the proposed Memorial is disapproved, and no further action can be taken.

# Overview: Memorials Process (Senate Bylaw 90)

## Part II. Consideration by Entire UC Academic Senate Membership

- Memorials to the Regents approved in accordance with the previous slide are submitted to a ballot of all voting members of the UC Academic Senate.



### OUTCOME OF PART II.

A Memorial that has received a majority of the valid ballots cast is sent by the Systemwide Senate Chair to the UC President for submission to the Regents.

# Overview: UCR Memorial Consideration Process

## Key Dates for UC Riverside Divisional Consideration

- **January 14, 2025:** Divisional Chair notification to Senate faculty.
- **Mar 11, 2025:** Town Hall to discuss Memorials.
- **Mar 11 – Mar 17, 2025:** Divisional vote.
- **March 18, 2025:** Due date to report UC Riverside Senate outcome.

## Vote Options (per Senate Bylaw 90)

- **Approve**
- **Disapprove**
- **Decline to Act** (*a vote cast without judgment on the merits of the memorial*)

## Authority

- Set conditions for admissions
- Approve & supervise courses, curricula, & academic programs
- Determine degree requirements
- Select its members
- Choose its own organizational committee structure

## Advisory

- Faculty appointments, promotions, and separations
- Appointment of Administrators
- Violations of Faculty Code of Conduct
- Budget issues and financial planning
